

## Drum Clamp

Drum Clamp - Forklifts are utilized to deal with moving, lifting and storing pallets. For businesses which handle products in drums, you have to use an attachment so as to move, lift and store them. There are various drum forklift accessories which you can acquire for all of your drum storing and moving requirements. These attachments are specially designed so as to deal with drum containers - thus there is no chance of damage to the product or drum container when they are lifted, stored or moved.

### Drum Positioner And Grab

The drum positioner can be used to load and unload drums off of vehicles, racks, and drum stands. These are presented in three or four tine models. This particular attachment is totally mechanical, thus allowing the operator to operate all from the comfort of the forklift seat. Able to move steel, large and extra large plastic drums, its capacity is 210 liters. This accessory is meant for drum pyramid stacking.

The drum grab is fork designed and mounted with the sole objective of dealing with steel drums that have rolling hoops. Although the purpose for the design was to deal with steel drums with rolling hoops, the drum grab could accommodate the transporting of large and extra large plastic drums. Drum capacity maximum is 220 liters for plastic barrels and 210 for steel drums with rolling hoops.

### The Rotator

The drum rotator is one more lift truck attachment which mounts onto the forks themselves. Their purpose is to be able to pick up the drum and rotate it upside down. The drum is clamped into the drum rotator using a clamp that fits around the middle of the drum. The rotation is performed by either a continuous loop chain or a crank handle. The crank handle is for operations that take place below shoulder level. For operations that must take place over shoulder level, the continuous circle chain will be used.

Drum tines are straightforward fork mounted accessory which could be utilized for stacking and unstacking 210-liter steel drums. Stacking requires nothing elaborate, just easy horizontal positioning of the drums. The carriage-mounted attachments decrease the load center of the drums.

### Automatic Tongs

Drum tongs are available both semi-automatic and automatic versions that could be used in the open topped and tight head steel drum styles. The drum tongs could likewise be connected in many various ways to the forklift. One way is to connect them underneath a fork-mounted hook. One more way is to connect them to a carriage mounted jib or a fork-mounted jib. Both the semi automatic and the automatic have a drum capacity of 210 liters. With the automatic, there is no requirement for the operator to ever leave the seat of the lift truck.

### Rim Grip Handler

When drums need storage space with limited area accessible, the Rim Grip Drum Handler is the ideal option in drum forklift accessories. This particular attachment would work for either the 210 L drums along with 120 L drums. The Rim Grip Handler functions by using metal jaws in order to hold the rim of the drum. It picks the drum up and sets it down without needing any space between all the drums. The average model in the trade is a zinc-plated handler, even if, this particular accessory comes accessible in stainless steel for the food and drink industry.
